



3-1-a Admission requirements

Study requirements: Participation recommendations

- Enjoyment of movement and interest in eurythmy movement; no previous experience is required;
- Interest in language, music and the anthroposophical study of the human being and the desire to study these in depth in a medical context;
- Interest in eurythmy therapy and its therapeutic possibilities and effectiveness;
- Joy of learning;
- Openness to engage in one's own learning process.

Admission requirements

- Minimum age 21 years;
- Upper secondary school certificate or equivalent. (The procedure for determining equivalence to a secondary level II qualification is carried out according to the "Guidelines for Secondary Level II Qualifications and Equivalences" of the OdA KT);
- Admission interview with members of the training college;
- Admission is usually based on a personal interview as soon as all application documents are available.

Remarks

- Visits are possible at any time by appointment/agreement.
- The first trimester (proseminar) is considered a probationary period.
- The training contract, which is drawn up at the beginning of the training, must be reconfirmed in each academic year by the location and evaluation interview with the college. If therapeutic or social skills are lacking, the training contract can be terminated.

Registration

Prior to the admission interview, the following documents should be submitted to us:

- Application for admission, with a recent passport photo.
- Curriculum vitae in tabular form with a description of your educational background.
- Letter of motivation stating why you have chosen the vocational training programme in healing therapy.
- Medical certificate stating that you meet the physical and mental requirements for the profession of therapist.
