# **Basic Eurythmy Therapy Training Dornach Study information** (subject to change)

#### **Training duration and degree**

This new basic eurythmy therapy training is an innovative training project. It combines the basic eurythmy training with the eurythmy therapy training and leads:

After 4 years (full-time, including proseminar and all compulsory internship periods) to the branch certificate (BZ/OdA KT), Complementary Therapist in Eurythmy Therapy. With this branch certificate, the EMR registration application can be submitted. The successful EMR registration allows a professional activity with health insurance and AHV settlement.

#### Further degree options (optional):

- After 5 years (dual study in the 5th year: 50% education with in-depth modules and 50% professional practice with supervision) to the "Goetheanum Diploma" / Diploma of the Medical Section.
- After 6 years (with at least 50 % professional practice over 2 years from the branch certificate, incl.
  HFP preparation modules) to register for the federally recognized Higher Professional Examination,
  (HFP / OdA KT). (State-recognized professional qualification: Complementary therapist with federal diploma in the eurythmy therapy method).

#### **Situation Europe / International**

With regard to the - in its basic structure comparable, but academically oriented - European Bachelor-Master system (Bologna educational guidelines), a cooperation with the Alanus University in Alfter / Germany is aimed at.

#### This training will meet the following recognition criteria:

- Swiss certification procedure for continuing education institutions / EDUQUA.
- Organization of the work complementary medicine / OdA KT
- Eurythmy Therapy Professional Association Switzerland / HEBV-CH (Method Identification OdA KT)
- Medical Section at the Goetheanum / Internat. Coordination Anthrop. Medicine / IKAM

#### **Participation requirements**

- Enjoyment of eurythmic movement, no previous experience is required.
- Minimum age 21 years
- Secondary school diploma
- Medical health certificate
- Interest in eurythmy therapy and its therapeutic possibilities and effectiveness.
- Interest in the anthroposophical study of man and the need to study it in depth in a medical context.

**Opportunities for observation** are possible on request at any time (until the start of training in autumn 2020 also in the existing eurythmy therapy training for certified eurythmists).

#### Language of instruction

Classes are held primarily in German or, if necessary and possible, in English. It is desired to learn the German language within the first years of study. Possible translations can be organized depending on the enrollment.

#### **Training dates (see trimester plan)**

The first semester is a trial period for all participants, which is concluded with the individual assessment interview.

#### **Training fee**

- for students without previous professional income: CHF 2'200.- / trimester (indicative fee\*)
- for students with previous professional income: CHF 2'800.- / trimester (indicative fee\*)
- (\* Classification and reduction by arrangement / Financial support in the form of scholarships, donations, interest-free loans, etc. will be discussed individually and can be applied for).

Included in the training fee: Coaching and supervision during the training period, as well as mentoring during the internship.

Admission fee CHF 120.-, diploma fee CHF 150.

#### Scholarships, donations and financial support

This basic eurythmy therapy training is accepted by the SERI (State Secretariat for Education, Research and Innovation). After passing the Higher Professional Examination /HFP of the OdA-KT, the tuition fees up to CHF 10'500. - can be reimbursed directly by the State Secretariat for Education, Research and Innovation (SBFI) Bern.
